COMPLIANCE WITH BRANDING GUIDELINES

All Certifying Organizations are required to comply with PVSA branding guidelines. The branding guidelines apply to all instances where a Certifying Organization (CO) publicly discusses the PVSA. This includes digital materials such as social media posts, PowerPoint presentations, online flyers and announcements, as well as physical collateral like banners, invitations, signage and displays for events. Certifying Organizations that do not adhere to the branding guidelines in public materials, including social media, will be asked to remove or revise such materials. If a Certifying Organization fails to comply with requests to change public materials and/or continues to not comply with branding guidelines, suspension or permanent termination as a PVSA Certifying Organization may occur.

AWARD NAMING CONVENTIONS

When referring to the name of the award, the word "volunteer" must always be included. The use of any specific president or vice president name is not permitted.

DESCRIBING THE PRESIDENT'S VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARD

When promoting your PVSA honorees and/or an event where your honorees will receive their awards, you may be issuing a press release or speaking to a local publication about the PVSA program. The following is approved language you can use when describing the award:

- The President's Volunteer Service Award, an initiative of AmeriCorps and administered by Points of Light, recognizes the vital role volunteers play in enhancing America's strength and national identity.
- The President's Volunteer Service Award is a prestigious civic honor bestowed by the President of the United States to individuals who have shown an exceptional commitment to volunteerism.
- The PVSA celebrates those who have made a significant impact through their dedicated volunteer service to communities and the nation, inspiring others to follow their example.

DESCRIBING YOUR ROLE AS A CERTIFYING ORGANIZATION

A Certifying Organization is an organization that has been granted authority through an application and review process to award the PVSA to volunteers. Certification to give out the PVSA is granted at the organizational, not individual, level.

APPROVED LANGUAGE	EXAMPLE OF UNAUTHORIZED LANGUAGE
We are a PVSA Certifying Organization.	Jane Doe is a certified PVSA presenter.

Points of Light administers the President's Volunteer Service Award program on behalf of AmeriCorps.

While Certifying Organizations access Points of Light administered platforms to apply for the program and purchase awards, it's important to note that there is no formal official partnership between Certifying Organizations, Points of Light and AmeriCorps.

The use of names or images of the president, vice president or AmeriCorps in any PVSA public materials is not permitted. Additionally, use of the President's Lifetime Achievement Award image is not permitted.
